What means fairness in a finite world? How can justice be done to the Southern demands for equity without overburdening the planet? The Jo'burg Memo, product of a unique assembly of 16 activists, intellectuals, politicians and businesspeople from across the world, gives an answer that challenges both North and South. It is arguably the most comprehensive and ambitious civil society contribution to this Global Summit, and has been received with excitement at presentations in many capitals and at the PrepComs of this summit.

The Jo'burg Memo provides a critical analysis of the 10 years since Rio, its merits and failures. It develops a Johannesburg Agenda for fairness in a fragile world, and presents a set of proposals for this Summit and the years ahead.

At the time of the Summit, the Jo'burg Memo is available in nine languages (English, Spanish, German, Italian, Hungarian, Russian, Arabic, Indonesian and Turkish) – further editions are in preparation.
